

VISIT TO THE WALLACE COLLECTION with Rupert Dickens

The Wallace Collection is a national museum based in Marylebone housing masterpieces of painting, furniture, arms, armour and porcelain. Rupert Dickens, a regular TASD lecturer, works at the Wallace and has kindly offered to lead a private guided tour for members on Thursday 3 December at 11am. The tour, which will focus on highlights of the Collection, will last for about an hour and is fully accessible.



Neither Rupert nor the Wallace Collection is taking a fee, but we are asking for £6 towards Society funds and admin. There is a maximum of 20 guests.

The nearest Tube stations are Bond Street (7 minute walk), Marble Arch (10 minutes), Oxford Circus (12 minutes) and Baker Street (13 minutes). Bus numbers 2, 10, 12, 13, 30, 74, 82, 94, 113, 137 and 274 all stop nearby. Please meet in the entrance vestibule at the Wallace Collection by 10.55am so that we can make a prompt start.

There is a stunning glazed courtyard café and restaurant at the Wallace, where you may wish to enjoy a coffee before or lunch after the tour.

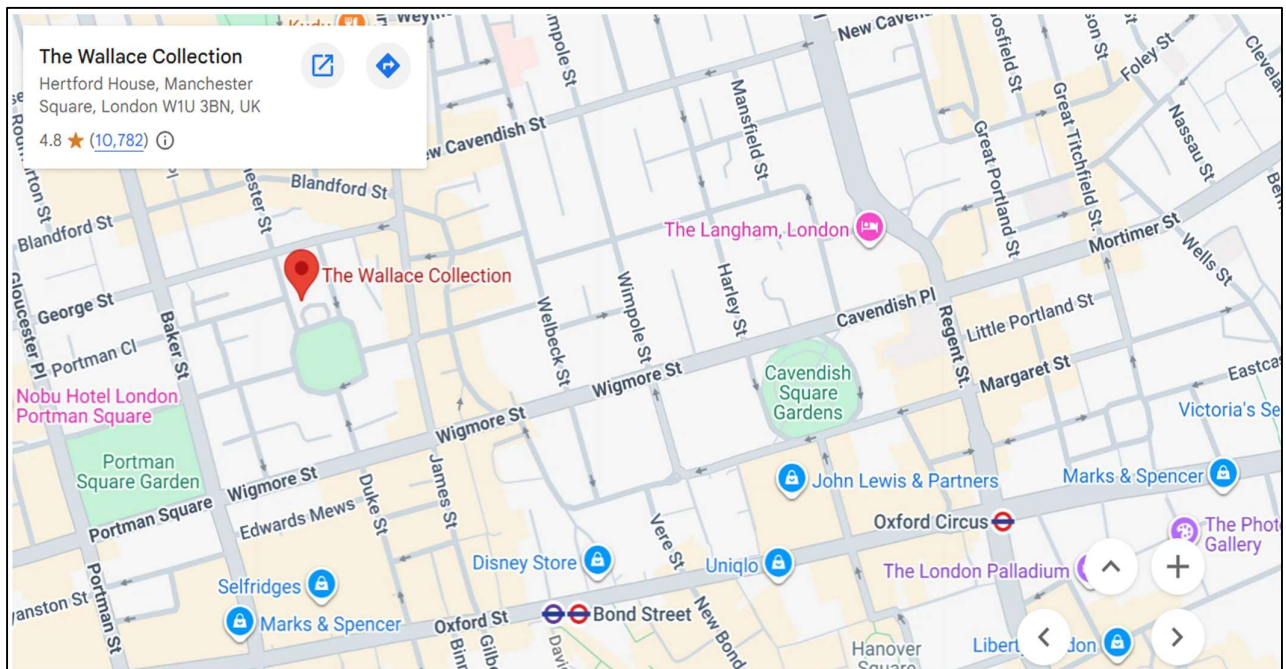
