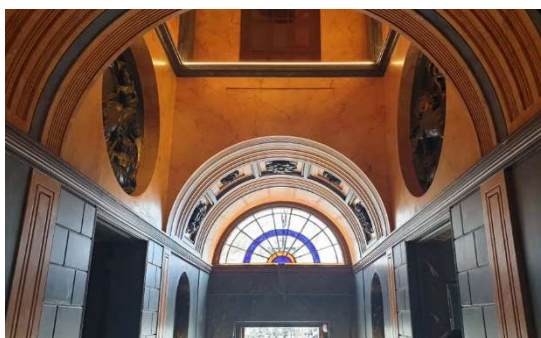


VISIT TO PITZHANGER MANOR AND GALLERY
Walpole Park, Mattock Lane, London W5 5EQ
11-12pm guided tour, Wed 13 July 2022



Pitzhanger Manor is the former home of the neoclassical architect Sir John Soane. Built 1800-1804, the Regency manor is a rare example of a building designed, built and lived in by Soane himself. He intended it as his country house in which to live with his family as well as entertaining guests.

The Manor has recently undergone a transformation, enabling visitors to explore Soane's architecture up close, getting an insight into the mind of one of Britain's most influential and idiosyncratic architects.



We have arranged a one-hour private guided tour at 11am on Wed 13 July. After that you will be at leisure to explore the park and gardens, or visit the free exhibition of works by artist Rana Begum RA, exploring the perception of light, colour and form.

Refreshments (not included) are available at cafés in the walled garden and Walpole Park. The Manor and Gallery are fully accessible and toilets are available.

Ealing Broadway is the nearest Tube (Central & District lines) or mainline from Paddington, followed by a 10 minute walk. **The cost of the guided tour is £15 per person** and we need 15 people to make the visit viable. Bookings must be made by Friday 24 June.

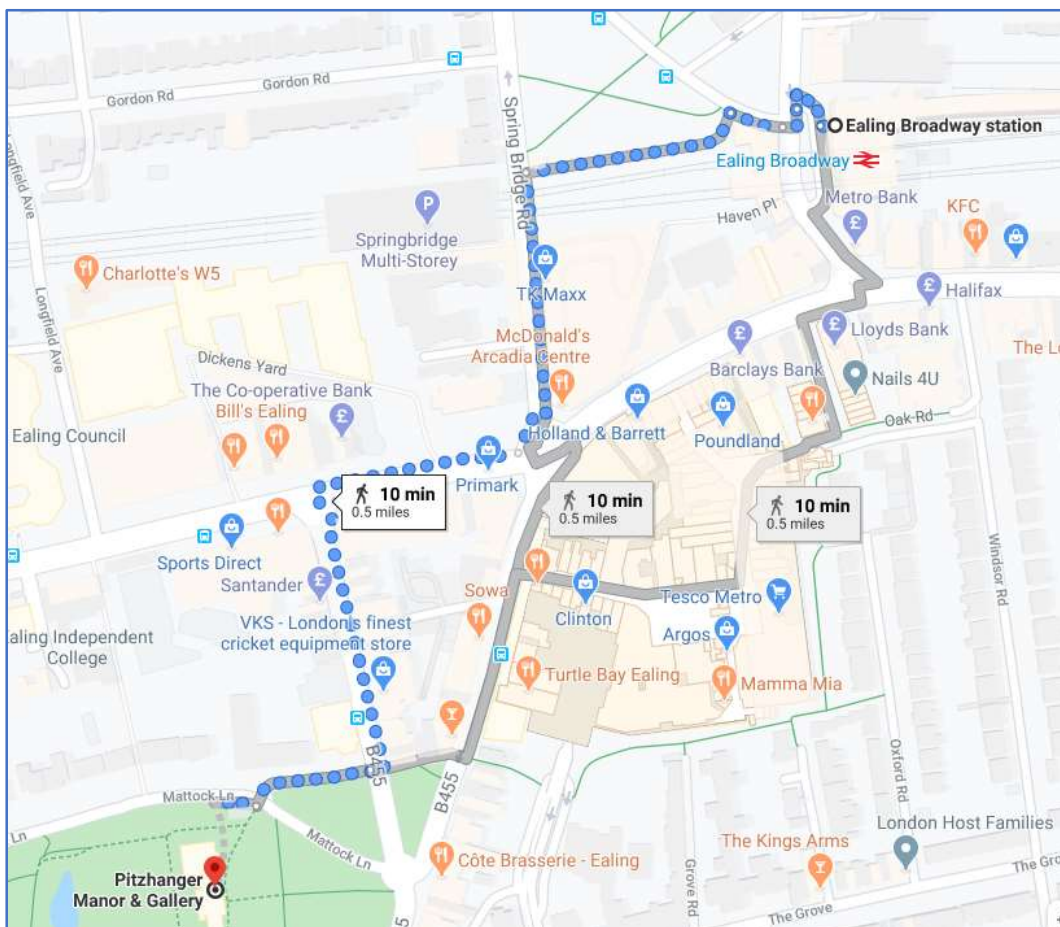
