

AFTERNOON VISIT TO THE CONSERVATION WORK AT ST BARTHOLOMEW'S HOSPITAL

West Smithfield, London EC1A 7BE
Tues 12 November 2024, 3.00-4.00pm



Experience the restoration of the Grade 1 listed North Wing of St Bartholomew's, the world's oldest hospital, by viewing its conservation in action at close quarters. On this guided tour, we will see what is being done to restore the North Wing of the hospital, which includes the Great Hall and Hogarth Stair.

The easiest way to Barts is via Thameslink trains from Herne Hill. They run every 15 minutes (23 minute journey), or from

London Bridge every five mins (seven minutes). Get on at the front of the train at Herne Hill and leave at City Thameslink via the [High Holborn exit](#). It's then a short walk to Barts; turn left and right at the traffic lights. Alternatively buses 59, 56, 46, 8, 25, 76, 100, 4 & 133 stop nearby. The cost of the visit is £17 per person. The tour lasts an hour. Only 15 places available.

On arrival, make your way to the fountain in the square inside the hospital grounds and wait for our guide, who will be wearing a high-vis jacket.

Visitors will be provided with full PPE: a hard hat, sanitized steel-capped boots (please wear or bring your own socks) and a high-vis gilet. The tour involves 31 steps up a scaffold staircase to the viewing platform. If you can't manage the climb, you are still encouraged to come as you will be able to engage with the work taking place from floor level. Folding stools will be provided.



Please meet promptly at 3pm to allow time to change into PPE. You will be asked to sign a form accepting the safety rules that apply to this visit.

Because of the restoration work there are currently no toilets in the North Wing; please use those in the West Wing before the start of the tour.


