William Morris was a revolutionary force in Victorian Britain. His work dramatically changed the fashions and ideologies of the era and he remains as influential and important today as he was in his own time.

The William Morris Society was founded in 1955 to share knowledge of the life and works of William Morris amongst its members and the wider public.

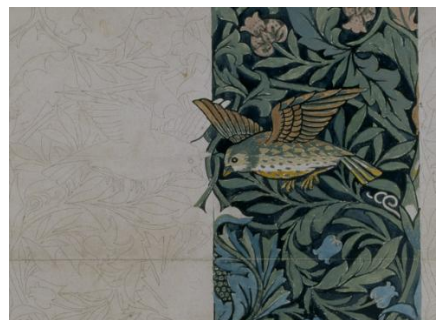

Our guided tour will last one hour and will introduce you to the museum, the historic Coach House and the lower rooms that bring Morris's creativity to life, immersing you in his original designs, personal artefacts and the spirit of the man himself. You will be free to explore the permanent exhibition – **Practically Magic: William Morris at Home in Hammersmith**

The Coach House, Garden Room and disabled toilet are accessible via a ramp.

The closest tubes are Ravenscourt Park (10min walk) on the District Line or Hammersmith (15min walk) on the District, Circle, Hammersmith & City and Piccadilly Lines.

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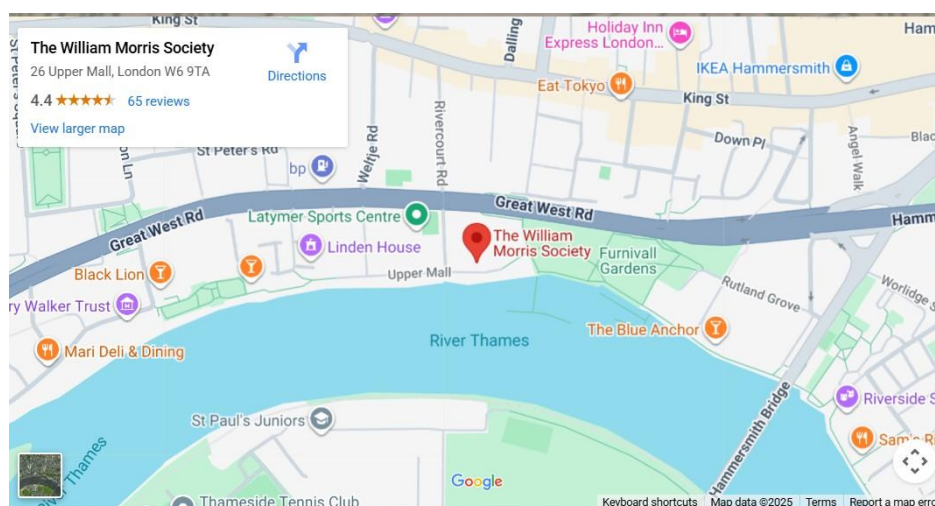
