

VISIT TO THE CHARTERHOUSE
Charterhouse Square, London, EC1M 6AN
Wednesday 17 June, 11.30am £15

The Charterhouse has been an almshouse since 1611. However, its fascinating story dates back to medieval times and the era of the Black Death. It has been a medieval monastery, a grand Tudor mansion and a school. Our guided group tour will explore this history through Charterhouse's buildings and collections and cast new light on well-known stories from British history.

Our tour will commence at 11.30am and will last an hour. The tour does not include the Chapel or museum but you are free to explore these in your own time. Please aim to arrive by 10.30am to see them before the guided tour or allow time to do so after the tour at 12.30pm.



The nearest Underground stations are Farringdon (take the Barbican exit from the Elizabeth Line) and Barbican. Please note there is no access to The Charterhouse or Charterhouse Square from Clerkenwell Road or Queen Mary University of London Charterhouse Square Campus. If you are having difficulty locating The Charterhouse, look for the Malmaison Hotel which is next door to the Gatehouse entrance.

All parts of the tour are wheelchair accessible and there are portable chairs available to borrow.

There is no café on site, but there are many cafés and restaurants nearby.

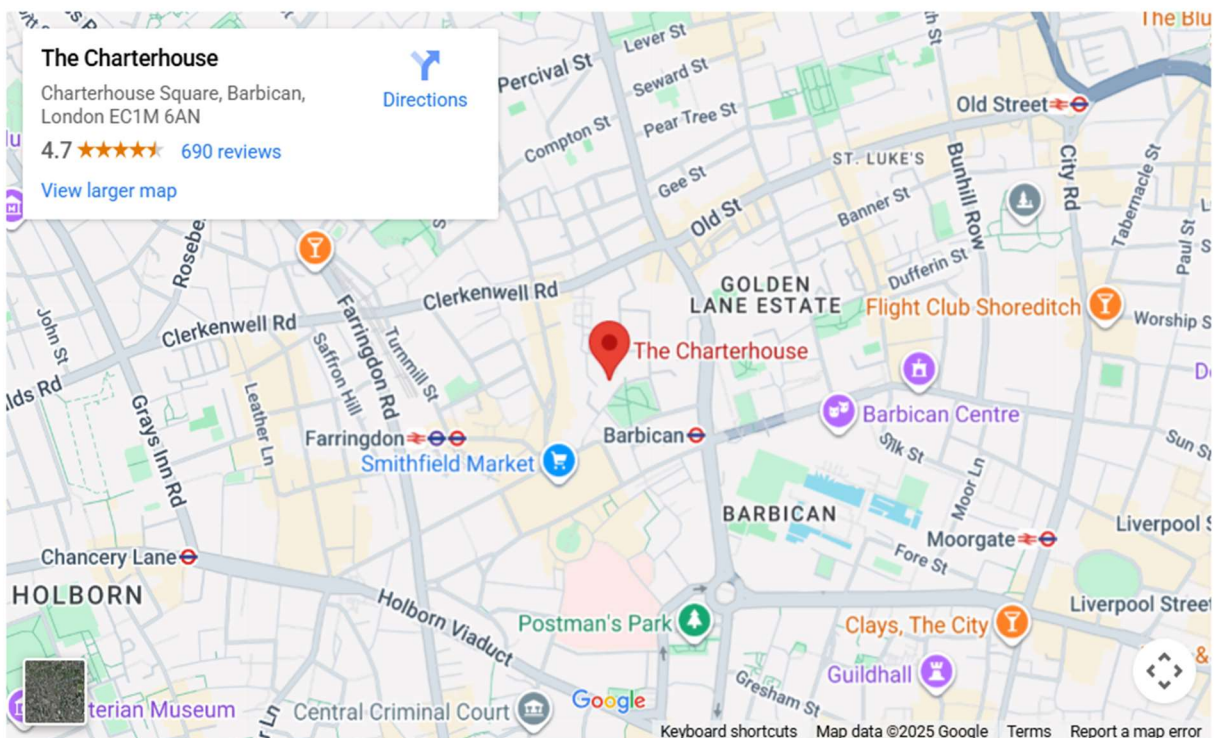
