

VISIT TO PITZHANGER MANOR AND GALLERY  
Walpole Park, Mattock Lane, London W5 5EQ  
2pm, Friday 1 May 2020



Pitzhanger Manor is the former home of the neoclassical architect Sir John Soane. Built between 1800 and 1804, the Regency manor is a rare and spectacular example of a building designed, built and lived in by Soane himself. He intended it as his country house, a domestic space in which to entertain guests as well as his family.

The Manor has recently undergone a transformation, enabling visitors to explore Soane's architecture up close, getting an insight into the mind of one of Britain's most influential and idiosyncratic architects.

We have arranged a private guided tour of the building at 2pm on Friday 1 May. It will last for an hour, after which we can visit the summer exhibition at the Pitzhanger Gallery entitled *Hogarth: London Voices, London Lives*. The Manor and Gallery are fully accessible and toilets are available. Afternoon tea (not included) is available at Soane's Kitchen in the walled garden.

Ealing Broadway is the nearest mainline (Great Western, nine minutes from Paddington) and Tube (Central and District lines) station, followed by an 8-10 minute walk.

The cost of this visit is £19 per person.

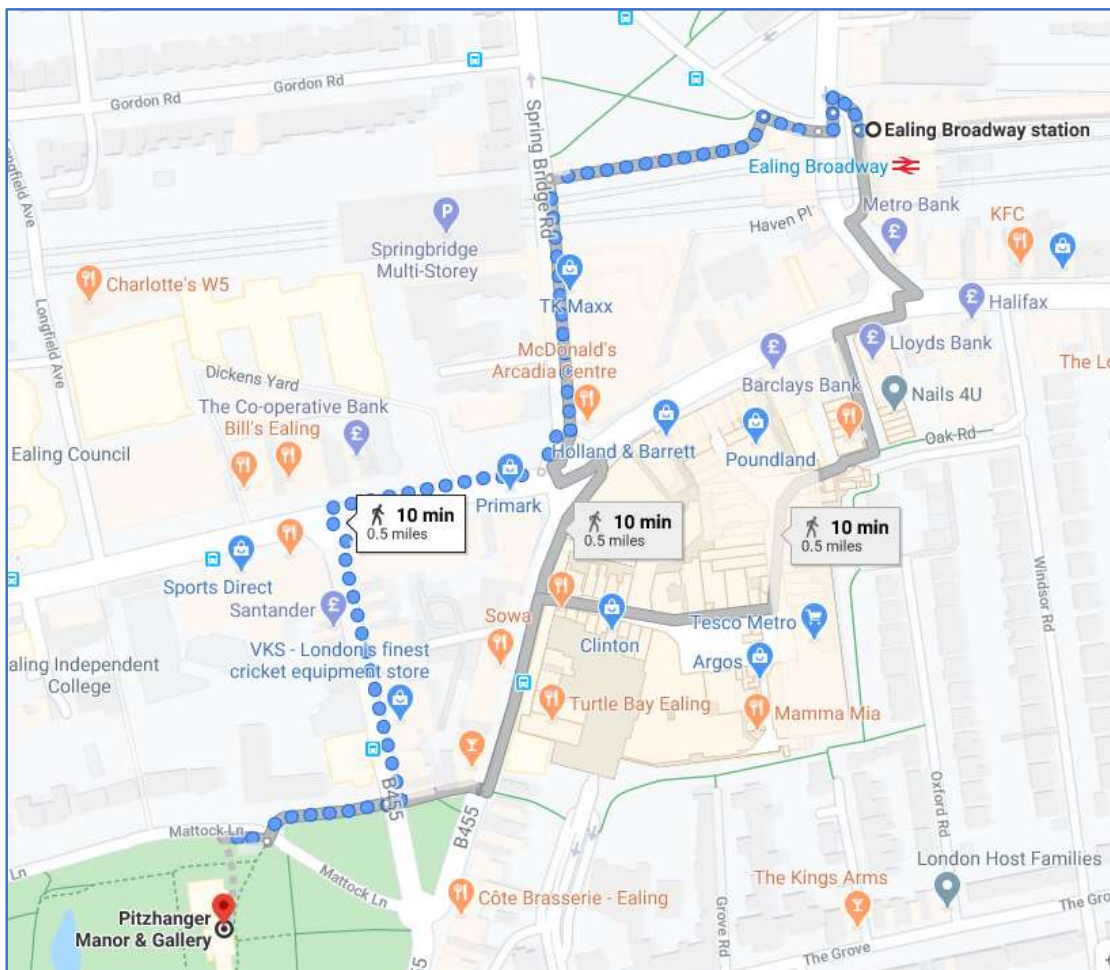
